

Educational Specialist

The Educational Specialist provides information and options on educational matters to parents with school aged children to help them build their advocacy skills. The specialist can also assist in developing and/or providing a clearer line of communication between the school and family in order to ensure that any and all possible academic options for the student have been considered. This service also includes but is not limited to a change in academic placement within the school district or another facility, educational accommodations, or requests for additional supplemental services (i.e. OT, PT, SLP). Our specialist can also provide Clearbrook's clients with added support in order to ensure communication between the school and the family that is conducive with the educational/behavioral needs of the client. Services such as consultancy, classroom observations, attendance at IEP meetings for additional support or within the role of advocacy, coordinating services with BCBA's and other support staff are all included within the specialist's services. Information and/or support for our clients who feel they are in need of additional assistance with the planning and/or implementation of school-provided services can request a referral be submitted through their service facilitator.
