ONE ROUND MANTOUX SKIN TEST

Clearbrook Mandates:

1. Each Clearbrook Direct Care Volunteer shall have a record of tuberculin skin test initiated prior to volunteer assignment or no later than 30 days after volunteer assignment using the Mantoux method.
2. All Direct Care Volunteers with significant skin test reaction (positive) shall have an x-ray and other medical examinations/treatment as required. Clearbrook can help with scheduling.

The direct care volunteer's one round Mantoux Test will be done prior to volunteer assignment or no later than 30 days after volunteer assignment. The test may be read by the volunteer after the test is administered by a facility nurse/physician and the designating nurse/physician signs the form below.
